Assembly Audit

Prior to the Assembly Meeting on Wednesday, July 17th, Faithful Trustees **SK Dennis M. Makurat, PFN**, **SK David J. Todd, Jr., PFN**, and **SK Matthew T. West, PFN** conducted the annual audit of the Assembly's books, and they found everything to be in good order. There was both good news and bad news that came out of the Audit:

- *Bad News:* Currently 43 Sir Knights are in arrears... some for multiple years. The unpaid dues totals \$2,065... this is money that could be used to cover the Assembly's expenses. The Faithful Trustees will work with the Faithful Comptroller to reach out to those in danger of being suspended from the 4th Degree.
- *Good News:* On July 1, 2018, the Assembly had a cleared balance of \$9,075.36; on June 30, 2019, that balance was \$11,183.78... we increased our coffers \$2,108.42 (imagine if all dues were paid in full!)!!! This is the first time in several years that we were in the black for the year.

Anyone who is in arrears (whether it is one year or more) is strongly encouraged to contact Faithful Comptroller **SK William W. Weich**, **PFN** as soon as possible to discuss options. It is the Assembly's strong desire to NOT suspend anyone... but we need to hear from those who are in arrears if they wish to maintain their membership in good standing.

The Faithful Trustees would like to commend Faithful Comptroller **SK William W. Weich, PFN** and Former Faithful Purser **SK Paul F. Cataldo** on another job well done in managing the Assembly's finances. A special thank you to SK Cataldo on the many years of service as our Faithful Purser, and best wishes to **SK A. Thomas White** as he assumes those responsibilities.
