# **Comptroller's Report**

As of the May 19 Assembly meeting, our Assembly membership stands at 335 Sir Knights. This number does not include the six new members who joined the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree and our Assembly on April 17. Supreme is in process of adding them to our records.

#### Assembly vs Council

4<sup>th</sup> degree Assemblies function similarly to that of Councils, however, they are SEPARATE entities and have separate charters. Also, each Council and Assembly separately assess dues. Councils are comprised of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree members, and are led by a Grand Knight. Assemblies are comprised of 4<sup>th</sup> Degree members from assigned feeder Councils and are led by a Faithful Navigator. To be a member of an Assembly requires members to also be in good standing with their Councils. When attending Council meetings, members are required to present their Council membership card. However, attending Assembly meetings and 4<sup>th</sup> Degree exemplifications requires the presentation of BOTH the Council AND Assembly membership cards.

There remain 30+ members who still have not paid. If you have not received your 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Dues Notice, please contact me and I will forward to you. Please remit payment as soon as possible.

Several members are in arrears in the Assembly dues for multiple years. #### **50 Swords Initiative**

Just a kindly reminder that there are incentives for purchasing Regalia and becoming a part of our Assembly's Color Corps:

 A new Sir Knight who purchases Regalia within the first year after they receive the Honors of the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree will be reimbursed up to \$150 for the purchase of their sword! A motion passed at the beginning of the Fraternal Year extends this to the first 10 Sir Knights who have already been in the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree over a year.

- The first 10 Sir Knights to purchase their Regalia and sign an agreement with the Faithful Comptroller will receive a \$100 rebate from the Assembly.
