Much of this was written prior to the March meeting, in preparation for a visit to "new life."

The fraternal year is rapidly nearing an end, and the beginning of the new year with new officers. The Lenten season ended with the new life of the Resurrection on Easter and upcoming birth of the Church on Pentecost, and now with the death of a pope and election of a new pope.

We are provided with constant reminders of life and death and the fact we cannot determine the timing. It is up to God! In one case, the death came unexpectedly without all of the opportunities to tell the departed how much they were loved and meant. In a couple other cases, the individuals were finally called home after long and trying periods of illness. Yet another individual continued to live (until recently) months after the announcement that death was imminent. God hadn't given the time yet.

God continues to bring forth new life. Whether it is our own children, or grandchildren, or it is the child of a friend or acquaintance, we are reminded that youth is important and revitalizes our spirits. We are reminded that new life is also fragile, and thank God for the wonders of present day medicine and health care.

The Assembly, and indeed the Order, looks to new members for revitalization. It is important for all of us to recruit new members to our councils and the order, to recruit members into the Fourth Degree and recruit Fourth Degree members into the Honor Guard as well as recruiting their active participation. Unfortunately, some of our recent honor guard opportunities have had a only limited number of members in regalia present, a very poor example of our visibility. Fortunately, these occasions are rare. The George Washington parade in Alexandria had 42 members (various Assemblies) present and marching. Bystanders along the parade route applauded our presence. This is the goal we need to continue striving for.

To the above, I now add that after a long reign, we have witnessed the dignity of death on Pope John Paul, The Great. Most of the above was written prior to his death. However, the end of one Papacy and start of another is an excellent example of the theme of this letter. It has provided lessons on the renewal of our beliefs that I could not possibly have touched. The death replaced sad circumstances relating to the Teri Schiavo's death in the media. The Pope's death and replacement were more closely followed than any other in my lifetime. I cannot help but be reminded of how important the Catholic Church and its leadership is. All eyes watched how the Church proceeded with the change of leadership.
