The Navigator's Report

Greetings from Ottawa, Canada! Although I will be back in the Washington area by the time you read this, my business trip this week is significant in many ways, and relevant to our Assembly.

As you know, our Fraternal Year draws rapidly to a close. As I write, the Pennsylvania primary election is taking place. Being "north of the border" reminds me of the patriotic duty we all have to exercise our power of the ballot box.
