Worthy Sir Knights,

"So that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us that the world may believe that you sent me." John 17:21

Assembly Mourns Passing of PFN Owen



On Thursday, May 25th, 2019, Faithful 2-Year Trustee SK Richard P. "Dick" Owen, FDD, PGK, PFN, succumbed to his battle with cancer.

A long-time fixture of Fr. Walter F. Malloy Assembly #1894, SK Owen was well known for his positive attitude and quick sense of humor. Those who knew him were quickly endeared to him. He served as Faithful Navigator during the 1990-1991 Fraternal Year, and was pressed into this service again for the majority of the 2015-2016 Fraternal Year (after the formation of Fr. Thomas A. Casey Assembly #3596). He often assisted the Assembly by stepping in as a Trustee when a sitting Trustee needed to resign from their 3-year term, and frequently served as an Associate Color Corps Commander. Active in his Council, his parish, and in the town of Annandale, he was beloved by Brother Knights, Fellow Catholics, and his neighbors throughout town. He frequently traveled to the Veterans Administration Hospital in Martinsburg, WV, bringing joy to the veterans who were patients there, and was a regular in the kitchen of Christ House in Alexandria, VA, serving dinner to the homeless... among other works of mercy he was known for. In 1998, Master of the Fourth Degree SK William M. Mulvihill, PSD, named SK Owen as the Sir Knight of the Year for the Virginia District. In the words of **SK Richard D. Muñoz, FDD, PGK, PFN**, "We are richer for his presence and poorer for his passing..."

Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let Thy Perpetual Light shine upon him. May his soul, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

Assembly vs. Council

4th Degree Assemblies function similarly to that of Councils, however, they are SEPARATE entities and have separate charters. Also, each Council and Assembly separately assess dues. Council are comprised of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Degree members and are led by a Grand Knight. Assemblies are comprised of 4th Degree members from assigned feeder Councils and are led by a Faithful Navigator. To be a member of an Assembly requires to also be in good standing with their Council membership card. However, attending Assembly meetings or 4th Degree exemplifications requires the presentation of BOTH the Council AND Assembly membership cards.
