The next Exemplification for the Fourth Degree is upon us. The Exemplification will be Saturday, November 2, 2019, at All Saints Catholic Church (9300 Stonewall Rd., Manassas, 20110). We have a number of Candidates already approved by the Assembly to take the Patriotic Degree. Our last opportunity to vote on Applications will be the October 16th meeting... so please continue to recruit for our local Exemplification!

Sir Knights are welcome and encouraged to attend the Exemplification as Observers. The Exemplification begins promptly at noon (Candidates need to report NLT 11:15 AM). Sir Knights attending the Exemplification should wear the Official Regalia Dress, or the Social Dress Uniform.

Candidates for the Fourth Degree must wear dark (black, grey, or blue) suit (jacket and trousers must be same color) with a plain white shirt (NO button down collars or French cuffs), and a conservative/traditional style tie. Brown, green, or other color suits are not authorized. Candidates should not wear any pins on their jacket lapels. The Social Baldrick and PG-113 pin will be provided to the Candidates during the ceremony. Priests should be dressed in clerical attire; Deacons may wear clerical attire as allowed by Diocesan guidelines. Active Duty Military, Law Enforcement, and Fire & Rescue personnel may wear their dress uniform.

A combined hospitality room will be available for snacks and beverages on the evening of Friday, November 1st, at the hotel.

This Exemplification is a great chance to afford our Brother Knights the opportunity to join us in the Fourth Degree and for us as current Sir Knights to reaffirm our commitment to full Patriotic Knighthood in the Knights of Columbus. I hope to see you at the Exemplification.

Wreath Laying

Fr. Malloy Assembly will once again be participating in a Wreath Laying ceremony on Columbus Day at the Tomb of the Unknowns, Arlington National Cemetery. This is an annual tradition begun soon after the founding of the Assembly and is one of the highlights of the Fraternal Year. All Sir Knights in the Assembly are welcome and encouraged to attend and participate.

The Wreath Laying is scheduled after the 4 PM Changing of the Guard on Monday, October 14, 2019. A van will transport Sir Knights from Providence Hall (leaving no later than 2:45 PM) directly to the Tomb of the Unknowns... a \$10 donation from each passenger to help cover the cost will be greatly appreciated; all other participants will need to park at the Visitor's Center and walk to the Tomb (there is a shuttle that operates from the Visitors Center to the Tomb of the Unknowns... details, including prices, may be found at www.arlingtontours.com).

Those who have the new Official Regalia Dress (ORD) are encouraged to wear it with Service Baldric and White Gloves, but **NO Sword** (ANC does not permit any weapons, including ceremonial swords, on the premises... for those coming from Union Station, please leave your sword in your vehicle); Active Duty Military and First Responders may wear their Dress Uniform; all other Sir Knights should wear their Social Dress Uniform (SDU), including Social Baldric with dark suit.

Honor Flight Arrival

Please consider joining us at the Fairfax Marriott at Fair Oaks (11787 Lee Jackson Memorial Hwy, Fairfax, 22033) on Friday, October 18th, at 6:45 PM as veterans of World War II and the Korean War travelling with the Northeast Tennessee Honor Flight arrive for their Tour of Honor in our Nation's Capital to see their respective memorials. Because they travel into our area by bus, these brave men and women who answered the call to serve do not get the opportunity to experience the Hero's Welcome Reception other veteran groups enjoy when they arrive at Reagan or Dulles airports.

Those who wish to participate should muster at 6:30 PM in Official Dress Uniform (ORD) with Sword, or in Social Dress Uniform (SDU). And please bring your family and friends to help welcome these heroes!

We can never repay them for the sacrifices they made for our country so many years ago, but we can come out and show them our appreciation. Hope to see you and your family on the 18th.

What Constitutes ORD & SDU

Official Regalia Dress (ORD)

This is the uniform as introduced by the Supreme Master and Vice Supreme Masters at the Opening Mass of the Supreme Convention in 2017. It includes a dark blue blazer with the Fourth Degree Emblem on the left breast pocket, dark gray trousers, a dark blue tie with gold Fourth Degree Emblem emblazoned the length and width of it, and a black beret with a Fourth Degree flash over the left eye (in some cases, a patch may be worn behind the flash). A white dress shirt (without button down collar or French cuffs) is to be worn with the ORD, as well as black socks and plain black dress shoes. When called for, the Service Baldric can be worn over the blazer, along with white gloves; additionally, the sword may be worn. Social Baldric and name badge are NEVER worn with ORD.

Social Dress Uniform (SDU)

This can be used by those who do not have the ORD. It includes a dark colored suit (black, dark blue, or dark gray; jacket and trousers should match in color), along with a conservative or traditional style tie (no bow tie or bolo tie; designs should be tasteful). A white dress shirt (without button down collar or French cuffs) is to be worn with the SDU, just like the ORD, as well as black socks and plain black dress shoes. The Social Baldric is worn under the jacket, attached to the trousers. A name badge MAY be worn with the SDU.

ORD & SDU

The PG-113 Fourth Degree Lapel Pin is worn either in or at the same level as the buttonhole, centered on the lapel. Incumbent Officers, be they in the Third or Fourth Degree, should wear their Jewel of Office (for those who hold multiple positions, only one jewel is worn at a time). And finally, those who have earned Past or Former titles should wear the corresponding miniature ribbons, centered just above the left pocket, and parallel to the floor.
