The usual schedule of meetings and events is suspended due to the covid-19 situation. However, the Virginia District Biennial Meeting was conducted by webinar on March 21,2020. The following is a brief recap of that meeting:

Reports by the District Master, District Secretary, and District Marshall. Resolutions:

Resolution 1 March 2020 Degree, submitted by the Master

This resolution would allow family and guests to attend the Fourth Degree Exemplification. This puts the Exemplification in accordance with the new Exemplification of the Virtues of Charity, Unity, and Fraternity. - Approved

Resolution 2 March 2020 Friar, submitted by Assembly 1162

This resolution would expand those eligible to serve as Friar to Priests, ordained Deacons, and other ordained clergy. The purpose is to address the difficulty in appointing priests as Friars in a time of severe Priest shortages.

- Approved with some assemblies dissenting. (Malloy Assembly being one)

Resolution 3 March 2020 ORD, submitted by Assembly 1162

This resolution would allow SK's performing certain ministerial duties at Mass to wear a modified version of the ORD.

The ORD is the uniform of the Fourth Degree. Supreme is unlikely to modify it.

In addition, the official 4th Degree Dress which consist of a suit and social baldric is recommended for these type purposes.

- Approved.

Resolution 4 March 2020 Pin, submitted by Assembly 1162

This resolution would standardize the official pin placement of social dress with that of the ORD. - Approved.

About Carlo Acutis

Carlo Acutis was born in Italy on May 21, 1991 and died of leukemia on October 12, 1996 at the age of 15. He had a great devotion to the Eucharist and the Blessed Mother and used his talent with computers create websites honoring both. His illness prevented his dream of making a pilgrimage to all the locations of <u>Eucharistic Miracles</u> in the world, so he created a website which has also become an exhibition. The <u>Marian</u> <u>Apparitions site</u> records the apparitions and Marian shrines of the world.

Cardinal Angelo Comastri wrote of Carlos:

"To always be close to Jesus, that's my life plan".

With these few words Carlo Acutis outlines the distinguishing feature of his brief existence:

To live with Jesus, for Jesus, and in Jesus.

You can read more about Carlos at <u>CarlosAcutis.com</u>. Pope Francis recognized a miracle attributed to Carlos on February 21, 2020 but no date has been announced for his beatification.

Our next 4th Degree Exemplification is being planned for the Fall of this year. Now is the time to restart our recruiting, talking with the members of your Council who have not yet taken the Fourth Degree. Let them know what it was that encouraged you to take this final Knighthood step. The only requirement is that they be a Third Degree Knight prior to the Exemplification.
